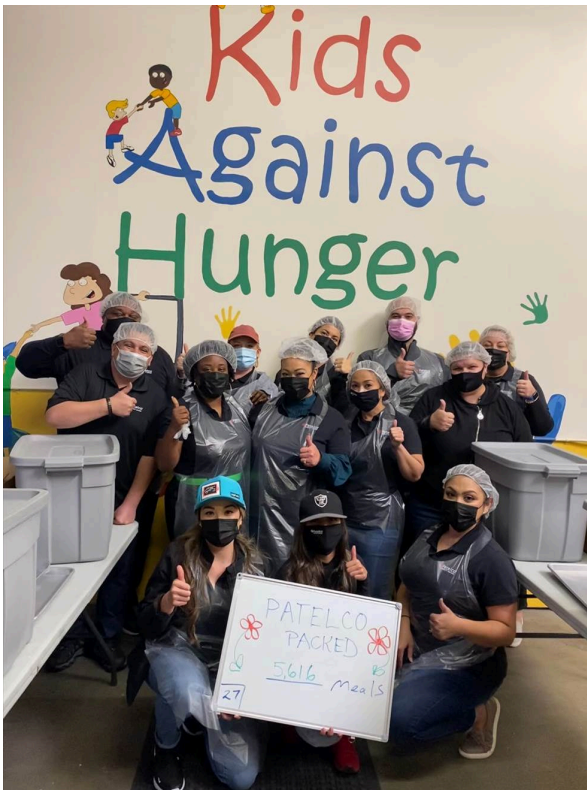


Patelco Credit Union Supports Kids Against Hunger Bay Area, Packs Meals for Families in Need in Haiti
