Almost \$200,000 in Scholarships and Educational Grants to be Awarded by Peach State FCU C.A.R.E.S. Foundation

LAWRENCEVILLE, GA (December 1, 2021) – Peach State Federal Credit Union is now accepting applications for its annual scholarship program. Almost \$200,000 in scholarships and educational grants will be awarded by the Peach State FCU C.A.R.E.S. Foundation to seniors in high school and professionals seeking career advancement. The scholarship program was established 20 years ago and honors the credit union's founders, past and present board members and employees, as well as the lifetime achievements of numerous distinguished school system and community leaders.
