Details: As part of its annual <u>ConnexCares</u> Holiday Drive, <u>Connex Credit Union</u> partnered with <u>Christian Community Action</u> throughout December to collect money and household items for homeless families moving into recently renovated apartments at the Hillside Family Shelter in New Haven.
