The credit union provided more than \$250,000 in monetary support to community based organizations and non-profits. ELGA stepped up to the plate quickly to secure more than 700 Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loans for member businesses, infusing the local economy with \$37 million and saving local jobs.

"We have supported the Grand Blanc community for quite some time, despite not having a branch here," said Terry Katzur, Executive Vice President for ELGA. "With the opening of our newest branch and the anticipated opening of our new HQ in 2022, I'm happy to know that we'll be making an even bigger impact, specifically for the local businesses in our new neighborhood."

Safety was top of mind during the event. Attendees enjoyed a beautiful day outdoors and were treated to live music from Jazz on Wheels, and boxed lunches were provided to ensure the highest safety standards.
