## January 30 Application Deadline Approaching For Bay Federal Credit Union Education Scholarship

**Capitola, CA – January 25, 2021** – Bay Federal Credit Union is now accepting applications for its 2021 Education Scholarship contest. Up to three winners will each receive \$1,500 to pay for post-secondary education expenses at any accredited college, university, trade/technical school, or career education program. The deadline for submissions is Saturday, January 30, 2021.

Eligible applicants must have a Membership Savings Account with Bay Federal Credit Union when submitting their applications, and must be either a current college or career school student, be on track to receive a high school diploma or GED certificate by July 1, 2021, or have plans to reenter college or career school in the fall of 2021.
