Northeast Credit Union Leagues Collaborate to Deliver Volunteer Education

Virtual session will help credit unions create a sustainable post-COVID strategy

In the spirit of cooperation, credit union leagues in the Northeast came together to create a timely, online training session designed to help credit union volunteers create a post-COVID strategy for their institutions. The webinar, *The Way Forward: Post-Pandemic Strategies for Your Credit Union*, will take place on June 29 from 5:00 - 6:00 pm. The event is being offered thanks to the collaborative efforts of the <u>Cooperative Credit Union Association</u>, <u>New York Credit Union Association</u>, <u>Association of Vermont Credit Unions</u>, <u>CrossState Credit Union Association</u>, <u>Credit Union League of Connecticut</u>, and the <u>Maine Credit Union League</u>.
