Nusenda Credit Union Held Its Annual Meeting on April 27, 2021

Albuquerque, N.M. – Nusenda Credit Union conducted its 85th annual meeting on Tuesday, April 27, 2021. The meeting reviewed the Credit Union's successes and community support during 2020 throughout COVID-19. Highlights focused on the Credit Union finding unique solutions to help members maintain access to their accounts and address a range of difficult personal situations. In addition, Credit Union leadership shared that through employee giving, Nusenda financial contributions, Nusenda Community Rewards®, sponsorships, a COVID emergency response fund, and other programs, Nusenda and its employees contributed almost \$1.3 million to communities and people across the state. Director of Financial Reporting at Presbyterian Healthcare Services Craig Kallsen, and Director of the College Enrichment & Outreach Programs at the University of New Mexico Jose Villar, were reappointed to the Supervisory Committee.
