CLF	Central Liquidity Facility	Created by Congress in 1979 to serve as a backup source of liquidity for federally insured credit unions; administered by the NCUA.

A STABLE CORPORATE CREDIT UNION SYSTEM STILL DEMANDS ANSWERS AND PAYMENTS

The Temporary Corporate Credit Union Stabilization Fund is no longer charging for the bailout, but when will credit unions get their share of the settlements?



The financial health of the corporate credit unions that serve the movement seems to be fair overall, judging by the numbers in the pages ahead.

As a whole, they report a capital ratio of 8.29%, annual share growth of 8.63%, and a collective ROA of 0.37%. But how much healthier would the system look overall if the NCUA would return to its rightful owners the billions of dollars the agency has secured in settlements from the big banks whose toxic securities doomed the corporate credit union system and led to the creation of the Temporary Corporate Credit Union Stabilization Fund?

Indeed, the NCUA could accomplish much in terms of transparency and accountability to Congress, credit unions, and the nation's 106 million credit union members by simply being open about how it plans to manage and distribute the \$4.3 billion it has secured in settlements. Even better would be to actually distribute that money to its rightful owners.

And that pool of money is growing. The five asset management estates (AMEs) the NCUA created to manage and then liquidate the remains of the corporates it seized during the depths of the Great Recession reported a \$570.1 million gain in total equity during the second quarter of 2016. This is on top of the \$161 million gain the regulator reported for the five AMEs during the first quarter of 2016.

The primary source of the second quarter increase was approximately \$714 million in legal recoveries from the investment houses that sold toxic securities to the corporates. That \$714 million resulted in a net gain of \$519 million after the NCUA paid its lawyers \$195 million. Each of the estates also recorded an increase in asset values and net spread income, according to NCUA figures, bringing the total gain for the second quarter to \$570.1 million.

But the NCUA has not made public how it distributed the funds among the AMEs. And the agency has yet to return a single dollar it has recovered from Wall Street to the credit unions that invested in these corporates.

The need for transparency and clarity only grows as the 2021 date for the TCCUSF to be shut down draws nearer.

Neither of the current NCUA board members were at the agency during the corporate takeovers and subsequent liquidations. Thus, chairman Rick Metsger and board member Mark McWatters can chart a course that does not defend or debate the past but does ensure confidence in future NCUA decisions about the five AMEs and the TCCUSF.

Keeping credit unions in the dark about the sources and uses of funds has the opposite effect. Transparency should ensure the NCUA makes a timely and full disclosure, at least quarterly, that includes:

1. The sources and uses of funds for each AME and the TCCUSF.
2. The methodology and supporting details for asset valuation.
3. The persons responsible for overseeing these billions of dollars of credit union funds and make them available for public question and answer.

The ideal solution would be to add credit union capital shareholder representatives to the NCUA's oversight group to ensure credit union interests are always paramount. Such representation is not only consistent with cooperative principles but would also bring expertise that could enhance recovery options and decisions.

Although there are billions of credit union dollars involved, much more than money is at stake. The core of the entire cooperative financial system is trust: Members trust credit unions with their money; credit unions trust the NCUA to provide transparent and effective oversight.

Hopefully, when we send our 2018 Callahan Credit Union Directory to the printer at this time next year, we can report on the clarity surrounding the process and, even better, that the NCUA has returned funds to credit unions and their member-owners.



THE CUSO CHALLENGE

The time is now for a new paradigm of cooperation among cooperatives.

Credit Union Service Organizations are not a new thing, but now might be the most promising, and challenging, time yet for financial services cooperatives to cooperate.

It's not that credit unions don't cooperate today. They do, and in many different, constructive ways. CUSOs, in fact, include some of the industry's largest providers as well as most promising emerging shops.

As opportunities and competitors continue to evolve, the credit union movement needs to consider a new approach, a fresh paradigm that shifts scope, focus, nature, and priorities. We need to get to Collaboration 3.0.

COLLABORATION 1.0 AND 2.0

Traditional models of collaboration fall broadly into two categories. What I call Collaboration 1.0 is the extension model, engaging a large cross section of credit unions to extend the reach and capabilities of the entire system. This includes the leagues, Filene Research Institute, and many large CUSOs (e.g., CO-OP, PSCU, CSCU, CU Direct).

Collaboration 2.0 is driven by cost reduction and the need to aggregate sufficient scale and volume to support ancillary activities. There are myriad examples from core processors to specialists like myCUmortgage and back-room consolidators like Shared Services Solutions.

Both approaches deliver efficiency, greater capacity and capability, more choice and flexibility, and good financial and functional ROI for member-owners.

But too many CUSOs of both types seem to have a self-interested approach to competition that focuses on maximizing market share and income rather than service to clients, their member-owners, and the movement as a whole.

This competition among collaborators threatens to undermine what should be the greatest differentiating strength of credit unions.

ENTER COLLABORATION 3.0

Collaboration 3.0 is competing in the world of "disruptive innovation," as Harvard Business School professor Clayton Christensen calls it. It's where competitors — including all those non-financial services interlopers — gain wallet share by providing products and services adequate enough to consumers who feel over-charged and ill-served by market leaders who always focus on their most demanding and profitable

customers. That's what Christensen calls "low-end disruption".

It also occurs as "new market disruption" which is when the value proposition is improved so much that new consumer segments have access to products or services previously beyond their reach.

In both cases, it's the outcome that matters. New technology is not necessarily disruptive from a market perspective; it might not even be innovative from a market perspective. The same goes for a new business process or new business model. It's what you do with these innovations that determines their impact.

Those that have done the most — companies like Apple, Google, Facebook, and Amazon — have leveraged platform structures, networks, and advanced data analytics while simultaneously collaborating and competing.


CUSOs provide the ideal framework for credit unions to accomplish this themselves, but it won't be easy. Existing credit union systems and data structures are highly differentiated and generally incompatible. Competition also must give way to co-opetition.

That means that those who control access to processes and data must transform their operating models, replace proprietary systems and restrictive business practices, and change their myopic competitive focus from beating one another to enabling their credit union clients to be more competitive with the fast-growing array of for-profit financial services providers.

It also means managing things in an entirely new way, allowing for limited loss in traditional terms to make the ultimate outcomes better for everyone.

Arguably, this is the approach Google, Apple, Facebook, and even Amazon have all taken, fostering a world where short-term cost or sacrifice fosters multiple winners that collaborate as they compete.

If anyone can make it work, it ought to be the credit union industry. But doing so will require significant cultural, strategic, and operational changes. It will require building Collaboration 3.0. If credit unions can do it, they can become the disruptors rather than the disrupted.

TWO LENSES. ONE INDUSTRY.

A major merger re-arranges the leaders among ranks of credit union auditors.



Industry standards recommend credit unions re-evaluate their external auditor every three years. This section of the *Credit Union Directory* is here to help inform that process by providing two different views of market share, a list of leading firms, and detailed contact information.

In the chart “Market Share By Number Of Client,” the size of

the bubble is determined by the number of credit union clients — more clients equal a bigger bubble — and the color is determined by aggregate client assets — more assets makes the color darker.

In the chart “Market Share By Aggregate Assets,” the size of the bubble is determined by aggregate client assets – more assets equal a bigger bubble – and the color is

determined by the number of credit union client assets — more clients make the color darker.

Although there are some consistencies between the two, their differences illuminate the importance of considering each type of market share.

For example, in the first chart, PricewaterhouseCoopers is a small, dark orange dot. In the second, the firm is the fourth-largest bubble but is also the lightest hue of orange. Why is this? PricewaterhouseCoopers has a client with the largest asset base of all — Navy Federal Credit Union at \$77.8 billion as of midyear 2016.


CliftonLarsonAllen, LLP, again tops CPA firms for both number of clients (256) and aggregate client assets (\$214.3B). On both charts, the CliftonLarsonAllen bubble is both the largest and the darkest — and the firm is growing. It gained 10 new clients with more than \$40 million in assets in 2015.

Meanwhile, Doeren Mayhew merged with Orth, Chakler, Murnane & Co., in October 2015. As a result, at year-end 2015, it was ranked No. 2 in both clients (190) and client assets (\$130.0B). And although the top three entries this year claim 570 of the 2,562 credit unions of \$40 million in assets or greater, there are a variety of smaller regional auditing firms represented in the following table.

There are many choices. Choose wisely.


MARKET SHARE BY NUMBER OF CLIENTS




