DANIELLE PRUDHOMME

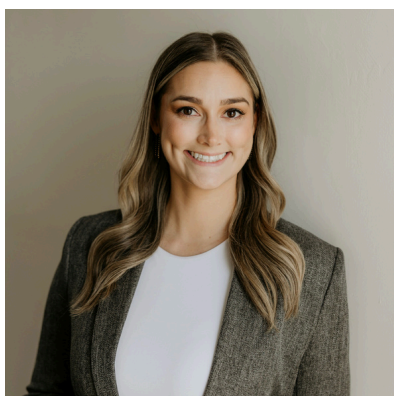
Promoted to Vice President of Digital Services
