FRESNO, Calif. (Oct. 8, 2025) – Educational Employees Credit Union (EECU) is now accepting applications for its Student Grant Program through Dec. 5, 2025.

EECU's Student Grant Program provides financial support to members pursuing higher education. Each year, EECU awards up to \$100,000 in grants to help students cover education-related expenses, such as tuition, books, and supplies.

The program is open to EECU members pursuing post-high school education at a community college, university/college, vocational/technical school, or advanced professional training in the United States or the District of Columbia. Qualified applicants who submit a completed application by the deadline will be considered for a \$2,000 grant.

"At EECU, we believe education is one of the most powerful investments a person can make," said Elizabeth J. Dooley, EECU president and CEO. "Through our Student Grant Program, we're proud to help support the dreams and goals of our members as they take the next step in their educational journey."
