TriUnity Foundation Receives Largest Single Investment to Date With Donation from Google

St. Cloud, MN — <u>TriUnity Foundation</u> is proud to announce it has received its largest single investment to date with a donation given by Google.

Google has donated \$10,000 as part of its Google Ad Grants, which provides nonprofits such as TriUnity Foundation funds in the form of in-kind search advertising.
